THE *PRISME* PROGRAM OF THE FRQNT AND FRQSC

Montreal, October 24, 2022 – On October 5, 2022, the [Association pour la recherche au collégial](#) (ARC) hosted an information session on the [PRISME](#) program of the Fonds de recherche du Québec – Nature et technologies (FRQNT) and Société et culture (FRQSC). The recording of this event may prove especially helpful to anyone wishing to submit an application for this competition. The replay will be available for viewing after you register.

Recall that the *PRISME* program is an opportunity to bring together the nature and technologies sector with that of society and culture. In this recorded session, the FRQNT program administrator Leira Retamal Covarrubias describes the objectives, eligibility requirements, application submission, evaluation, and changes made since the previous edition of the competition. The recording also contains the testimonial of David Guimont, co-coordinator of the Living Lab en innovation ouverte (LLio), a College Centre for Technology Transfer in Innovative Social Practices (CCTT-PSN) at Cégep de Rivière-du-Loup. Note that Guimont is collaborating with Habib Horchani (researcher with the Groupe de recherche en environnement et biotechnologie), also at Cégep de Rivière-du-Loup, and Steve Joncoux (researcher at the LLio) on the project [Biologie et autres sciences connexes : Sociologie de l'art](#) [Biology and other related sciences: Sociology of art], funded by the FRQNT and FRQSC. The participants agreed it was an informative presentation and applauded the proposed project. Remember that applications must be submitted via the FRQnet E-portfolio no later than 4:00 p.m. on November 14, 2022.
