**FRQS SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR COLLEGE RESEARCH**

Montréal, November 1, 2017 – On November 16, 2017, between 9:30 and 11:30 a.m., the [Association pour la recherche au collégial](#) (ARC) will be holding an information session entitled [Le Programme d'appui à la recherche pour les enseignants-chercheurs de collège du FRQS](#) [FRQS Research Support Program for College Teachers-Researchers].

Through its [Research Support Program for College Teachers-Researchers](#), the [Fonds de recherche du Québec – Santé](#) (FRQS) funds human health research activities carried out by college researchers. The financial assistance covers projects conducted in collaboration with university researchers, and consists of a salary award and a financial contribution to assist with research expenses. This program promotes access to research activities and equipment in centres recognized and funded by the FRQS, in institutions of the ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux and the ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur, and in College Centres for Technology Transfer specializing in human health. Since its relatively recent inception, the FRQS has provided support to 10 college researchers. Applications for the next competition must be submitted by 4:30 p.m. on January 16, 2018.

The ARC information session will focus on the program's objectives, eligibility requirements, ethical requirements and rules, as well as on what resources will be made available. Other topics include suggestions on how to prepare the best possible grant application, and common mistakes to avoid.

To ensure the information session on [Le Programme d'appui à la recherche pour les enseignants-chercheurs de collège du FRQS](#) is accessible to as many people as possible, it will be offered online and will remain accessible for up to six months after it is held. In addition, it will be possible to hold discussions with resource persons in either French or English.
